CONFIRMATION OF TANK STORAGE FEE AGREEMENT

Attn: All Sublessees / Authorized Transaction Participants

This Tank Storage Fee Agreement (“Agreement”) is issued by **Regional Shipping B.V. Tank Terminal** and governs the terms, conditions, obligations, and operational framework relating to tank storage services, document endorsement, and associated fuel transaction support services provided to Sublessees under active TSA/CPA arrangements.

This Agreement shall be deemed binding upon acceptance of payment and/or written acknowledgment by the Sublessee.

1. DEFINITIONS

For the purpose of this Agreement, the following definitions shall apply:

- 1.1 **“Terminal”** refers to Regional Shipping B.V. Tank Terminal.
- 1.2 **“Sublessee”** refers to any buyer, trader, or authorized entity utilizing storage and endorsement services.
- 1.3 **“Tank Storage Fee”** refers to the administrative, operational, and endorsement fee required prior to issuance of terminal documentation.
- 1.4 **“Documents”** include but are not limited to TSR, Q88, DTA, CIP, Inter-Tank Injection Agreements, NOR, and any supplier-requested verification instruments.
- 1.5 **“Supplier”** refers to any fuel provider or allocation holder involved in the transaction chain.

2. PURPOSE OF AGREEMENT

2.1 The purpose of this Agreement is to formalize the conditions under which the Terminal provides documentation endorsement, verification facilitation, and tank storage coordination services.

2.2 This Agreement ensures structured processing of transaction-related documents and maintains compliance within operational and administrative frameworks.



3. TANK STORAGE FEE REQUIREMENT

3.1 A mandatory Tank Storage Fee shall be payable prior to the issuance of any terminal-related documentation.

3.2 The fee is applicable for the processing, endorsement, verification, and administrative handling of all requested documents.

3.3 No TSR, Q88, or equivalent documentation shall be issued prior to confirmation of payment.

4. SCOPE OF SERVICES COVERED BY FEE

The Tank Storage Fee covers, but is not limited to, the following services:

- Document endorsement and validation
- Administrative processing of TSR/Q88 issuance
- Coordination of Inter-Tank Injection documentation
- Compliance verification assistance
- Terminal access facilitation
- Multi-supplier document handling within the validity period
- Internal operational routing and registration

5. REFUND POLICY

5.1 The Tank Storage Fee shall be fully refundable within twenty-four (24) hours only under the following conditions:

- a) Failure of supplier to provide verifiable proof of product existence and quality; or
- b) Written cancellation request submitted by the Sublessee within the refund window.

5.2 Refunds shall not apply after commencement of document processing or issuance of any terminal-related documentation.

6. VALIDITY PERIOD

6.1 This Agreement shall remain valid for a period of twelve (12) months from the date of execution or payment confirmation.

6.2 The Agreement shall apply to multiple transactions, suppliers, and documentation requests during the validity period unless terminated in writing.



7. TERMINAL INVITATION & MEETING PROTOCOL

7.1 Upon receipt of the Tank Storage Fee, the Terminal shall issue an official Invitation Letter to the Sublessee.

7.2 The Invitation shall facilitate a scheduled meeting with Terminal representatives at one of the following locations:

- Europoort, Rotterdam Port (Netherlands)
- Houston Terminal (USA)
- Fujairah Terminal (UAE)
- Jurong Terminal (Singapore)
- Zhoushan & Qingdao Terminal (China)

7.3 During the meeting, Sublessee representatives may review relevant sublease documentation and operational records for verification purposes.

8. COMPLIANCE AND VERIFICATION CLAUSE

8.1 The Terminal reserves the right to verify all transaction participants prior to document issuance.

8.2 All documentation is subject to internal compliance review and operational approval.

8.3 The Terminal may suspend or reject any request deemed non-compliant or incomplete.

9. NON-LIABILITY CLAUSE

9.1 The Terminal shall not be held liable for delays caused by incomplete documentation or supplier verification failure.

9.2 The Sublessee assumes full responsibility for ensuring accuracy of transaction data provided to the Terminal.

10. CONFIDENTIALITY CLAUSE

10.1 All transaction-related documents, communications, and operational details shall remain strictly confidential.

10.2 No party shall disclose information to third parties without prior written consent from the Terminal.



11. GOOD FAITH & BUSINESS UNDERSTANDING

This Agreement is executed in good faith with the objective of ensuring transparency, operational efficiency, and long-term cooperation between all parties engaged in tank storage and fuel transaction activities.

12. ACCEPTANCE

Acceptance of this Agreement shall be confirmed through payment of the Tank Storage Fee or written acknowledgment by the Sublessee.
